USE GUIDELINES

As DIY-Public WorksShop content is owned and copyrighted by APWA, the following use guidelines should be followed to preserve the integrity of the materials as well as the intended use and benefit of the product.

- The use and reuse of the materials should be limited to the purchasing body (chapter/ agency). The materials should not be shared with partners or collaborators of the purchasing body for their sole use.
- Chapters who purchase DIY-Public WorksShop Kits may share them with their branches for use at branch events, as branches are viewed as a chapter entity.
- There is no limit to the number of times the materials can be used/presented.
- APWA will update DIY-Public WorksShop Kits on a regular basis (typically every 3-5 years). Minor updates may be made available to current users, however if substantial changes to the materials are made, the purchasing body would need to purchase the latest version in order to have access to the latest program materials. Access to previous versions will not be impacted.
